

Privacy Policy

This Statement of Privacy applies to the MaxMyIRA.com website and governs data collection and usage. By using the MaxMyIRA.com website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

CatMark Inc. ("CatMark") may collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. CATMARK may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your Postal Code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

Information about your computer hardware and software also may be automatically collected by MaxMyIRA.com. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used by CatMark for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the MaxMyIRA.com website.

CatMark encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from MaxMyIRA.com so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. CatMark is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the MaxMyIRA.com and CatMark family of websites.

Use of your Personal Information

CatMark collects and uses your personal information to operate the MaxMyIRA.com website and deliver the services you have requested. CatMark, via MaxMyIRA.com, will send response email following requests for information and may also periodically send software and/or service updates to registered and/or inquiring users.

CatMark may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from CatMark. CatMark may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

CatMark does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. CatMark may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

CatMark does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

CatMark keeps track of the websites and pages our customers visit within MaxMyIRA.com, in order to determine what MaxMyIRA.com services are the most popular. This data may be used to deliver customized content and advertising within MaxMyIRA.com to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

CatMark websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on MaxMyIRA.com or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of CatMark; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of MaxMyIRA.com, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The MaxMyIRA.com website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize MaxMyIRA.com pages, or register with MaxMyIRA.com site or services, a cookie may help MaxMyIRA.com to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same MaxMyIRA.com website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the MaxMyIRA.com features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Security of your Personal Information

MaxMyIRA.com secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. MaxMyIRA.com secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
